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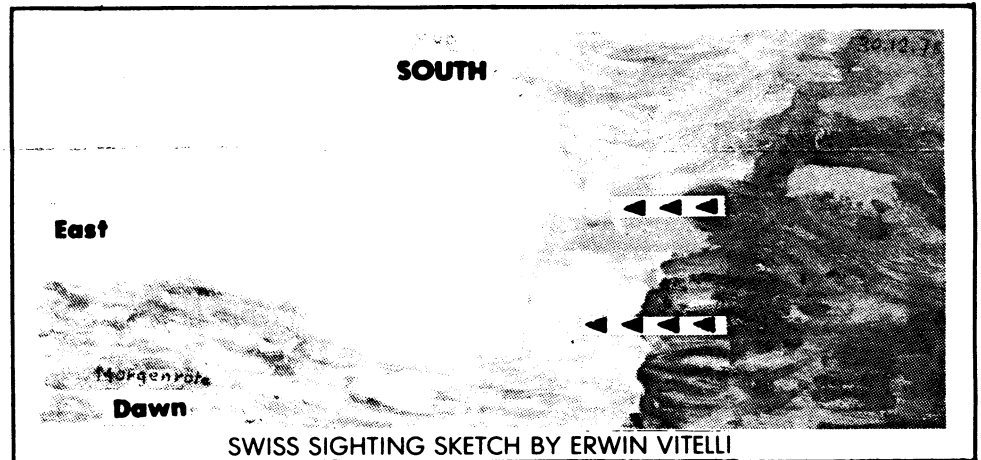
UFOs And The Compression Of Evolution Into A Cosmic Framework

Let us consider this possibility: A billion years ago a civilization in our Milky Way attained interstellar travel capability. A program to colonize the galaxy ensued. Assuming that the spacecraft sped 5 percent as fast as light, and that the average distance between planetary systems was 10 light years, 200 years were required to journey from one to another. Suppose that upon arriving at each selected planet the migrants spent another 200 years to render it habitable, build cities, expand their population, etc., whereupon they sent ships to the neighboring uncolonized planetary systems. Then their civilization propagated through the galaxy at 1/40 light year per year [(10 light years) ÷ (200 years travel + 200 years occupation)]; and our 100,000 light year diameter galaxy would have been conquered in a maximum of about 4,000,000 years, or in only 2,000,000 if the process began at its center.

But could UFOs be vehicles of galactic colonizers such as these? Roughly a billion years ago they should have appropriated Earth. Why would our planet have been bypassed until now?

The simple answer is that colonization started much more recently than I proposed, but the scenario is otherwise essentially true, and UFOs are colonial advance contingents. This seems improbable, inasmuch as the galaxy's age is 10 billion years and it may contain 100 billion planetary systems: Earth, at age 4.6 billion, is



within the middle range in the age distribution of planets, and almost certainly somewhere a civilization should have been the first to embark to the stars sometime on the order of a billion years ago (if, as is widely believed by knowledgeable people, life, spontaneous and evolving, is commonplace in the universe). Apparently, Earth in our time would only with minute probability be undergoing a takeover process of 200 years duration, or even a far longer one within a few-million-year galactic colonization program.

However, this conclusion presumes that life evolves independently on each world, including Earth, whereon it arises.

The actual answer may lie herein: Any civilization advancing in technology beyond a certain point no longer grows in a gross, heavy-handed way consuming ever more energy and materials per tenanted planet, nor does its population grow uncontrolled. Rather, analogously to the progress of our computers, it grows with more and more being accomplished by relatively less and less energy, materials, and labor.

Early Morning, Late December, Swiss Sighting

We have just received an interesting and very recent sighting report from a correspondent in Switzerland. The report written in German has been translated for us by ASSOCIATE Trudy McVicker. We quote directly from the English transaction.

"It was in the morning, about 7:30 AM, when I observed a steely-blue object with a clearly-defined outline standing motionless in the southern sky. Its shape was that of three globes merging into one another; each one of those globes had an individual light-source, apparently directed downwards. The object was clearly visible; it was surrounded by clear space, free of clouds. It was difficult to determine its size. It was several hundred meters above ground and a group of houses would have fitted inside easily. I was able to observe the phenomenon for about one minute and I experienced a sensation of fear at the sight of it.

Dr. Hynek:

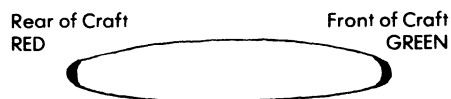
My earlier three (UFO sighting) accounts were published in the Aug/Sept 1982 (Vol. 3, No. 4) edition of CUFOS ASSOCIATE NEWSLETTER. My experiences were used in the newsletter as a multiple report, which I understand is somewhat unique.

I have since had an additional encounter which I feel is of added importance. Please be assured that publicity is unwanted and is not the reason for my concern. I would briefly like to draw your attention to the evening of October 18, 1982, 7:50 PM, Halifax, Nova Scotia. My wife, daughter and I had just crossed the bridge joining Dartmouth to Halifax after visiting relatives and our conversation was concerning that visit. Our exact location was Quinpool Road and Armview Crescent, which is still well within Halifax city limits and a busy area.

As we rounded this turn, my wife yelled, "What on Earth is that?" The attention of all three of us immediately turned to the sky and to our astonishment we viewed a craft traveling south to north and seconds later it arched to northeast traveling at an estimated constant velocity of approximately 50 miles per hour, making absolutely no sound.

We estimated the craft to be three hundred feet in the air and to be roughly eight times the size of a full

moon. The craft was the shape of a fat cigar, displayed a large round constant green light in front and a similar, but flashing, red light in the rear. It was grey in color. (We include a diagram of the shape and approximate color.) We had the craft in view for about 15 seconds, but as we left the city in the same approximate direction as the craft we decided to watch for it again and saw a flashing red light in the distance scribing circles, probably the same craft. This craft certainly was not a dirigible for it had no housing on the bottom, but was the exact shape of a cigar . . . (seen) at every close range.



I hope that these experiences are beginning to sound habitual because that's how it's beginning to feel. These experiences (together with five others from April 1979 through October 1981 involving balls of light which seemed, in several cases, to be attacking the car in which we were traveling) seem to be a bit much for one person.

My only purpose in writing this letter is to ask your professional opinion and explanation. I admit that I thoroughly believe in the existence of extra-terrestrial crafts and beings, but, at the same time, I don't go around expecting to see them. . . .

Since my second sighting referred to in the other ASSOCIATE NEWSLETTER article, I have had a compulsive, uncontrollable interest in UFO's but without a desire for same interest.

Would you suggest my following this avenue further by trying to find someone experienced in hypnosis in this field or do you feel that these experiences are not at all extraordinary and that I should forget the whole matter? Certainly I, in my own mind, feel that there is much more to this whole thing than meets the eye and would appreciate any help or explanation. Again, with regard to this letter and information contained within, I wish to remain anonymous for the safety of my employment. Thank you.

And the colonization is done thus economically, not by brute force. When existing life is encountered on a contacted planet, the colonists intervene minimally (much as environmentalist do not interfere in nature), although with ultimate effectiveness, accelerating and shaping evolution by well-chosen iotas here and there while not transforming its basic pattern — viewing their eventual integration with that life. Surveillance probes may be launched in advance, as well as "seeds" to establish life on hospitable planets and to speed up evolution where it is present. (Possibly, natural seeding began eons previously from organic material escaping into space.) The wave front of colonization is not sharp, as one might infer with the first paragraph; "colonization" is not really the proper word, and it generally takes far longer than 200 years to integrate a planet into the galactic community.

If true, this would mean: (1) that the spread between the levels of development of intelligent life forms around the galaxy could be drastically less than would be the case if the first interstellar civilization did not promote evolution towards its own state; (2) that accordingly, although life elsewhere may well have started a billion or more years earlier than on Earth, the most advanced beings, having received no help from outside, evolved to the dawn of their cosmic civilizing mission perhaps but ten million years ago, and now might be only thousands of years ahead of us technologically (more or less, depending on the extent of their progress since the outset of their space age and their specific policy of intervention upon Earth); and (3) that UFOs may indeed be advance contingents of the interstellar society.

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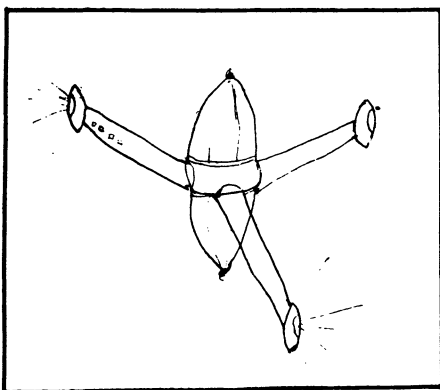
A New Model UFO?

CUFOS has a letter from Karl Stewart of Middlefield, Ohio which describes a somewhat different shape for a UFO. The shape is best described by the sketch shown here. Other researchers with similar design reports are invited to share and compare with us on this one.

Mr. Stewart writes that on March 21, 1982 he was driving from Concordia Theological Seminary in Ft. Wayne, Indiana to Middlefield, Ohio along Interstate Highway 80. He had been on the Interstate for approximately one-half hour driving East in northwest Ohio when he topped a hill and saw what at first he thought was a jet plane in a landing pattern.

He estimates the time to have been about 8 or 9 PM. What he thought were the landing lights were on and the object traveled East, parallel to the Highway on the right (South) side at a landing speed. Mr. Stewart says, "in fact, as it banked over the highway, I began looking to the left for the airport runway but was surprised to see a residential area." However, he still thought it was a large jet because the "landing lights were so far apart."

The object appeared to be hovering like a helicopter and he guessed the object was about 500 feet altitude, very near the North edge of the Interstate. The craft lights were "much brighter than ordinary landing lights and flickered twice to an intense white light." These, plus lights from the nearby residential area, permitted him to see it "very well and it looked like this."



As Karl Stewart stared at it with "the little windows, red and green strings of running lights, and bright white landing lights," his mind kept trying to fit what he was seeing into the conventional mold of a large jet. "But," he said, "I know now it was a UFO."

There was a string of traffic ahead of him and oncoming traffic, but no one stopped. Frightened, Stewart drove his car onto the shoulder of the road when the craft changed direction and slid back South across the Interstate behind him just about the trees. When it changed direction, it did not bank; but kept the same compass orientation with respect to the "arms." At the end of each "arm" was a large compartment and he believes the craft was at least "twice as large as a large jet" aircraft.

The radio in the car was turned on, but there was no interference with the radio signal. No sound from the craft was noticed. It floated more than flew. Mr. Stewart remembers that it gained altitude in a shelf-like fashion before it banked North over the highway.

Mr. Stewart hopes that others may have seen what he saw and will come forward to confirm the presence of this strange object that night in Ohio. □

Large Physical Trace Identified

Our readers will recall the cover article in our October/November 1982 issue which dealt with large circular physical trace cases. One involved a sighting in Ohio during July of 1978 which appeared coincident with the sighting of a strange object at the sight reported by two witnesses. That case remains unexplained.

The other case involved a large circular area in the midst of a corn field in northeast Nebraska. No object was reported seen at that location, but an unusually bright light "like lightning which lit up the whole sky" was seen shortly before the damaged corn field was found.

Arden Wild, of Stanton, Nebraska, was asked to investigate the report and advise CUFOS of his findings. He has done so and we submit his report here to share with our ASSOCIATES some of what is involved in seeking the answers to the mystery of the UFO phenomenon.

The series of photographs taken by George J. Myers were used to locate the exact site, three miles southeast of Winnebago, Nebraska, on U.S. Highway 73. Mr. Wild visited the area during November, 1982, and found that the present owner of the field in question is a new owner since 1980. The previous occupant was a tenant farmer, an Indian, who had moved from Nebraska and cannot be located.

Since—October of 1976, when George Myers photographed the site and took soil samples (which were sent to Arden Wild for local analysis and comparison with present soil sample chemistry), the land has been successively cropped with corn (1977), milo (1978), milo (1979) and corn each year since. On the site itself, the shallower-rooted crops did all right, but traces of soil damage remained when corn was planted. The present farmer has no knowledge of a chemical spill on the area, but thought it was possible there had been one, since only in 1981 and this year did the corn do well on the site. Wild reports that he could see no evidence of damaged soil during November. The crop was harvested by that time.

The 1976 soil sample was recently taken to be analyzed by a University of Nebraska agronomist and it is highly significant that the 1976 soil sample shows definite evidence of chemical spill.

Wild continues, "Various seedlings were planted in three groupings of the soil sample. All of the seedlings sprouted, yellowed and died . . . strong indication, even after this much elapse of time, of a herbicide damage to this sample. Soil nutrients in normal proportions had been retained in the sample. If this sample had been taken from the topmost layer, as I assume, lacking contrary statement, it shows that the herbicide content had been heavy, indeed, originally, further indication of a massive chemical presence. indicated either atrazine or sutan with atrazine, or atrazine chemical is shown in either case. This is the extent of the tests done on the sample.

"My own tentative guess is that the site had been inundated with a chemical spill, either in 1975 or, more probably, 1976, in the spring of the year. That is consistent with both the testing of the soil and lowland area of the site, which would tend to be more or less circular in the event of a chemical spill due to a ruptured tank or hose or hose connection; this is a circumstance not uncommon when a farmer applies chemicals by himself; he may not be as careful making his tank connection as a chemical company applier might be. I'm impressed by the chemical residue in the sample after all these years." □

Boston University Astronomy Professor Advocates SETI

In an article written by Patrick Young of the Newhouse News Service which appeared in the December 5, 1982 issue of ARKANSAS GAZETTE of Little Rock, Arkansas, Michael D. Papagiannis, professor of astronomy at Boston University said "at last we do have the science and technology to conduct serious searches for extra-terrestrial life" and he indicated that the search shouldn't be confined to distant stars.

"Some of us, including myself, feel it is important to conduct searches inside our solar system for intelligent signals," he said.

The rationale, he explains, is the suspicion that civilizations more advanced than Earth's may have colonized part of the galaxy, perhaps with a gigantic space station in orbit around the sun.

"These colonies are likely to be habitats in space because it is very unlikely — in spite of suggestions to the contrary by popular television — that any planet would provide them an atmosphere they could freely breathe," Papagiannis said.

Despite detailed biological arguments against the chances of life developing elsewhere, advocates say interest in SETI has never been higher among scientists and the public.

They list recent Congressional approval of funds to NASA for a capability and strategy study during 1983, interest by the International Astronomical Union in SETI, positive support from a National Academy of Sciences report and a private study which will undertake a scan of about two-thirds of the sky.

Papagiannis said the idea that extraterrestrial beings may have established a colony in the solar system is based on the belief that living creatures have an urge to occupy all available space, that technological civilizations inevitably will colonize the entire galaxy. "Life has a tremendous capacity to expand," Papagiannis said. "It is almost like a gas."

Run Or Stay? Responses To A Question By Mark A. Cooley

In our last issue, Dec./Jan. of the ASSOCIATE NEWSLETTER, we published a letter from Mark A. Cooley in which he raised the question of what to do in the event that one is confronted by a CE-II or CE-III situation. We asked readers to respond with their suggestions. Here we present two of the responses we have received, for ASSOCIATE Cooley and others to consider.

(From ASSOCIATE and MUFON Western States Director Paul C. Cerny:)

"For what it's worth, in my 27 years of investigation and research, I have interviewed hundreds of witnesses and have come across a wide variety of encounters. As Mr. Cooley states, the startled person's instinct would be to 'run like hell' from a CE-2 or CE-3 situation, and possibly be sorry for miffing the rare opportunity of a life-time. This is something for which I have conditioned myself over a period of years. I am determined to stand my ground and take my chances to see what happens. My feeling is that if no hostility whatsoever is taken or even anticipated on our part, no harm will occur, assuming we are

dealing with highly-advanced and sophisticated entities.

"Of course, we really cannot guarantee a gentle, no-harm behavioral pattern. It is speculated by one southern California scientist and others, that these alien entities may be coming here from a number of nearby galactic locations, thus differing in various modes of personal relationship to us terrestrials.

"As you may have read in recent accounts of UFO incidents, some people have apparently been harmed in a minor sense by radiation burns, sun burning (simulated), needle marks, partial and temporary paralysis, bruises, etc., but rarely anything more drastic. Mostly it seems like a cautious gesture on their part and control of us in methods of influenced temporary unconsciousness in some cases (time lapses), to initiate restraint against our lashing out in self-defense, apparently to prevent injury to them or to ourselves.

"However, it is my feeling that the mining case was definitely provoked by intended or deliberate violence on the part of the earthlings involved and, perhaps if mind-probed, anticipated by the UFO or crew, assuming it was either remotely controlled or occupied. Obviously, retaliation or self-defense was implemented in both cases on the witnesses for the UFO's protection as any one of u would do if threatened.

"They seem to speculate ahead of time in a possible hostile situation as if probing our minds.

"I'm sure there are other similar incidents of variation that have occurred down through UFO history, but keep in mind also that these could be quite accidental incidents by earthlings curiously approaching an "operating" vehicle and accidentally receiving minor injuries. Example: How is a landed jetliner pilot to know if some unassuming individual is foolish enough to walk behind the blast of the running jet engine of his plane, possibly getting burned and knocked down! That was pointed out by an airline captain friend of mine. The jetliner pilot would very likely be completely unaware of this person's approach to the "business end" of his aircraft.

"Many of the reports coming out of South America and a few from this country tell of some drastic bizarre experiences, but how reliable these stories are is somewhat questionable. The Cash-Landrum case in Texas, of course, is pretty well documented but still inconclusive. The personal physical damage here seems to have been accidental and not deliberate on the part of the object.

"The two cases I have personally checked on, out of several that come to mind, appeared to have been self-defense type of situations on the part of the objects confronted. Briefly, a Los Angeles man stopped his car

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years ago near Yuma, Arizona at 3:00 o'clock in the morning to observe a close encounter on the highway a couple hundred feet from him. Getting out to look at the brightly lit and colored series of lights, he reached back into the car seat to get his camera. He pointed it at the object and snapped one picture, then tossed the camera back on the seat. Then resting his elbow on the metal top of the car, he was subjected immediately to a beam of light from the craft momentarily, which resulted in a shock or burning sensation where his elbow rested against the car. This eventually resulted in a black mark on the bone of his elbow, showing up in X-rays, which has caused him considerable discomfort for over 20 years. It is particularly sensitive in front of color T.V., and no medical assistance has seemed to help. The point I wish to emphasize is that his act of aiming the camera may have been taken as an act of hostility toward the intelligence in the UFO.

"The other case involved the older mining couple near Redding, California, who for the second time within a period of about eight years, spotted a similar small 12-foot diameter, egg-shaped craft on the ground, in broad daylight, on their mining property. Yelling to his wife to 'get the gun, it's here again,' may have prompted the vehicle and/or occupants to protect themselves from possible harm or disabling the craft, by retaliating. It popped upward into the air about

100 feet and hit them both with some sort of invisible force that knocked them both unconscious for 15 minutes.

"Here is a typical example of intended hostility on the part of earthly inhabitants to an object of the unknown, which they did not understand. It is a somewhat natural reaction of us humans, placed in similar situations of surprise and mysterious objects, to shoot first and ask questions afterwards. Obviously, the opposite approach should be exercised, both in thought and actions. This could at least result in a friendly and intriguing experience." □

If such colonization has taken place, Papagiannis suggests, the most likely location is in the Asteroid Belt between Earth and Mars. "The Asteroid Belt consists of large rocks that can provide anything you wish in terms of raw materials," he said.

One question often asked about this theory is why contact has not been made before now.

"People have speculated on that," Papagiannis said. "Such colonies wouldn't have been established yesterday, but probably many hundreds of millions of years ago. For these highly-advanced civilizations, the Earth was a dull place — interesting maybe as a case study in biological evolution.

"And this was probably our relationship with them. We were studied

and they kept an eye on our slow evolution. And I think this even included the evolution of man, who — lacking technology and rather primitive science — did not represent an interesting subject of communication."

Even today, Papagiannis suggests, the time might not be ripe. He noted that many questions whether Earth's civilization will survive or be destroyed by nuclear war.

"It is impossible they don't want to interfere in our struggle, letting the natural process of selection determine if we are fit to become members of galactic society.

That leads inevitably to a possibility that makes him most uncomfortable. "It is conceivable — though I don't advocate this and I want to emphasize that I don't think this is the case — that some of the unidentified flying objects might represent missions from the Asteroid Belt keeping an eye on us." □
