Primary record ID number (**PRN**)

Order of primacy for records in a block concerning same incident (**X2**) ("0" = primary entry, "2" = secondary entry)

Indirect record ID number (**IRN**)

Flag for non-primary entries (**X1**)

UFOCAT 2022 unique record ID number (**URN**)

Author's Name or Investigator's Name (**AUTHOR**)

Level of source (**LEVEL**) (from "1" to "9": e.g. "3" is an investigating organization's case such as APRO, NICAP, CUFOS, or MUFON; "5" is a newspaper source; "7" is a first edition book; "8" is a revised edition book, "9" is a listing from a database without additional information available).

Code for identification of the direct source (**SOURCE**) (e.g. "JVallee12" is Jacques Vallee & Chris Aubeck's book, *Wonders in the Sky*)

Position within direct source, usually page number or case number (**PAGEVOL**)

Code for identification of the indirect source (**ISOURCE**)

Position within indirect source, usually page number of case number (**IPAGEVOL**)

Year of report (**YEAR**)

Month (**MO**)

Day (**DAY**)

Time (hour and minute) (**TIME**)

Special flag for reporting accuracy of date and time, daylight savings time (**TZ**)

Time Zone (**TZONE**) (1 - 24: with 2 for Hawaii, 3 for Alaska, 4 for Western US,...7 for Eastern US,...12 for GMT, 13 to Western Europe,...17.5 for India,...20 for China, 21 for Japan, 22 for Eastern Australia, and 24 for New Zealand)

Weather (**WEA**)

Terrain (e.g. "Forest", "Highway", "Farm", "City", "Mountain", etc.) (**TER**)

Vehicle Flag (e.g. indicating that the witness was in a car, boat, or airplane) (**VFLG**)

Place name location (up to 25 characters) (**LOCATION**)

Special flag for reporting accuracy about location (**LFLG**)

Region of world abbreviation (**REGION**)

State (or country) abbreviation (3 character code) (**STATE**)

County (or province) (**COUNTY**)

Number of witnesses (**WITS**)

Age of principal witness or age composition of group (**AGE**)

Sex of principal witness or gender composition of group (**SEX**)

Flag for military or police witnesses ("#" = military, "+" = police) (**MISC**)

Witness name(s) (up to 25 characters) (**NAMES**)
Absolute Sidereal Time (computed) (**AST**)
Hynek classification code (3 character code) (**HYNEK**)
Vallee classification code (3 character code) (**VALLEE**)
Credibility of report (SVP as defined by Vallee) (**SVP**)
Type and subtype of report (**TYPE**)
Flag for explainability of the report ("+" = good report, "*" = excellent report, "-" = probably explainable, "=" = explained) (**EXPL**)
Explanation of report (as given by source) (**EXPLAN**)
Number of objects (UFOs) reported (**OBJS**)
Duration of event (**DUR**)
Size of object estimated by witnesses (log base 2) (**SIZE**)
Apparent size (**AGLSZE**)
Distance from UFO at closest approach estimated by witnesses (log base 2) (**DIST**)
Color of UFO (**COLOR**)
Shape of UFO (**SHAPE**)
Sound (if any) associated with UFO (**SOUND**)
